These photos are examples of tools I would incorporate into imaginative play, where my students could communicate through play, or I could use play to model different social and emotional regulation skills. The Therapeutic Play course taught me that child-led play is the most successful method. Students would choose the toys or games they wanted to play and lead the session this way. The most popular choice amongst my students was the dollhouse. They would often choose to reenact scenarios from their homelife or in-school challenges using the dolls and dollhouse.

During sessions, this toy served as a family home, group home, classroom, rehabilitation centre, and so much more.
